### Year 2 Standard Assessment Tests (SATs) – Meeting for Parents/Carers

Dear Parent / Carer,

As you may be aware, at the end of Key Stage 1, which is the end of Year 2, children must complete Standard Assessment Tests (SATs). The purpose of these tests is to provide us with additional evidence about your child's attainment in Reading, Grammar and Mathematics, alongside our teacher assessments of Writing. The results of these tests will be used, alongside evidence collected throughout the school year and day-to-day teaching, to identify whether children are working at the expected standard for the year group, or working towards this standard.

These tests should not be a cause of stress or anxiety for your child – indeed, the children will not recognise these tests as anything particularly different than tasks they have completed before. Having said that, there are some simple ways you can help your child be ready for these assessments and ensure that they are able to try their best.

We are holding a **meeting for parents and carers on Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup> May**, after school at 3.30pm. It will only take around 20 minutes and will take place in the Year 2 classrooms. At this meeting, we will give you more information about these assessments, give you some advice about how you can support your child and answer any questions you may have. If you require it, Year 2 children can be looked after in a separate classroom while the meeting takes place.

Please attend if you are able, and let us know if this is not possible.
