Dear Parents / Carers,

Welcome back to school!

It has been so lovely to welcome you all back to school today for the start of an exciting year here at Willenhall Community Primary School. It was lovely to see some of our new parents and children and we look forward to getting to know you more over the coming weeks and months.

There has been a lot of activity at school over the Summer holidays, including a complete refurbishment of the children's toilets for Years 1 to 6 and a full redecoration of the Early Years. I would like to thank all of the staff who have worked extremely hard to ensure the school is ready for the children today.

Having taken advice at the end of the last academic year, we have made the decision to ban the use of motorised vehicles on the school site. This includes bringing these items onto the school grounds, even when they are not being ridden. This includes all electric powered / motorised scooters and bikes but does not include mobility scooters. Electric scooters should be viewed alongside any other motorised vehicle such as a car and can be very dangerous when on the school site for pedestrians and our children. The safety and welfare of our pupils is always our main priority and as such, this ban will come into force today. We actively encourage children and parents to travel to school on non-motorised scooters and bikes, which should be pushed once on the school site rather than ridden, again for the safety of the children, parents and staff. I thank you all in advance for your support with keeping our whole school community safe.

On Wednesday we are having a visit from Rock Kidz on Tour. The group will be coming into school to teach the children some rock songs especially designed to promote wellbeing and raise self-esteem. I am sure they will have a great time and will tell you all about it.

It was lovely to see all of the children looking so smart in their school uniform today. Thank you for your support with this.
